

Cleaning Responsibilities

Only those rooms that are used will require cleaning.



Sanctuary

Pick up any trash and take to large trash cans in fellowship hall, vacuum floors, wipe down pews, sanitize door handles

Upstairs Bathrooms

Clean toilets, pick up any trash, sweep and mop, wipe down sink, clean mirrors, sanitize door handles, and take out trash to large trash cans in fellowship hall

Fellowship Hall

Wipe down tables, put chairs on tables, clean any dishes used, wipe down countertops, rinse coffee pots, empty coffee grounds into trash, sweep floor and take trash to outside trash can once all other rooms are complete.

Fellowship Hall Bathrooms

Clean toilets, pick up any trash, sweep and mop, wipe down sink, clean mirrors, sanitize door handles, and take out trash to large trash cans in fellowship hall

Sparkies Classroom

Wipe down tables, pick up trash, sweep and vacuum floors, sanitize door handles and light switches, and take out trash to

large trash can in gym

Boys T&T Classroom

Wipe down tables, pick up trash, sweep and vacuum floors, sanitize door handles and light switches, and take out trash to large trash can in gym

Room

Girls T&T Classroom

Wipe down tables, pick up trash, sweep and vacuum floors, sanitize door handles and light switches, and take out trash to large trash can in gym

Activity Bathrooms

Clean toilets, pick up any trash, sweep and mop, wipe down sink, clean mirrors, sanitize door handles, and take out trash

to large trash can in gym

Activity Building Kitchen

Wipe down table and countertops, clean any dishes used, rinse coffee pots, empty coffee grounds into trash, sweep floor and take trash to large trash can in gym

Pavilion

Pick up all trash, wipe down all tables and countertop, and ensure any trash cans moved to the pavilion are moved back into the gym

Gym

Pick up any trash, put away any temporary tables and any chairs moved to the gym, sweep floor, and take large trash cans to outside trash can once all other rooms are complete

Picture Day


Kendra Scarborough will be taking School Pictures for our Coop.
